Rehoboth began in 1981 following a visit to the Philippines from the U.K. by Vernon and Connie Andrews. It was established in partnership with Pastor and Mrs. Luzano, who were the first house parents. Since then orphaned, abandoned

and neglected children and young people have been loved and cared for at Rehoboth Children's Home.

Rehoboth is situated in Santa Maria, a small village near the town of Camiling, in the province of Tarlac, on the northern island of Luzon.

In 2008 a non-residential support programme R.E.A.P. (Rehoboth Educational Assistance Programme) was established to provide educational assistance for local families who are unable to send their children to school or college for financial reasons. The family enters into a partnership with Rehoboth, and members of staff monitor attendance and progress, so maintaining regular contact with both students and their families.

The aim of Rehoboth is to provide for the spiritual, physical, educational and emotional needs of the residents and R.E.A.P. students, thereby giving these young people a hope for the future. The work is managed by a range of staff, including social workers, house parents and local and international volunteers, under the direction of the Executive Director.

• **Rehoboth Children's Home, Inc. (R.C.H.I.)** has a Board of Directors in the Philippines and is registered, licensed and accredited by the Department of Social Welfare & Development (D.S.W.D.)

• **Rehoboth Children's Home Trust (R.C.H.T.)** has a Board of Trustees in the U.K. and is a registered U.K. charity (no. 1005152).
